This workshop will enable elementary and secondary teachers, both novice and experienced, to acquire or strengthen their expertise in critical instructive areas, including establishing classroom procedures, disciplining with dignity, planning for long-range effective instruction, interacting with parents and other professionals, and assessment and record-keeping strategies. Beginning teachers can benefit from both the support of other novices and experienced teachers whose role is supportive, not evaluative. Experienced teachers may be ready to "refresh" their practice, exchanging practical solutions and acquiring additional tools for their teaching repertoire.

"Setting Up Shop: Launching a New School Year"

August 23, 2010 - 9:00 am to 12:00 pm

This workshop will enable elementary and secondary teachers to exchange ideas around the important topics of launching a new school year such as: classroom management, room arrangement, planning for effective instruction, establishing classroom community, procedures and routines that promote learning, efficient record-keeping, great read alouds and their use, and tips for substitute teachers. Participants will choose three discussion groups to attend, plus view and share examples of student work or activities aligned to GSEs and GLEs.

Both workshops will be presented by Marti Schwartz, a veteran elementary teacher from Smithfield, and Kathy Payson, a teacher at the Learning Community Charter School in Central Falls.
